Stanford Teacher Education Program

- STEP is a 12-month post-baccalaureate course of study for prospective elementary (K-6) and secondary teachers (7-12).
- 45 credits. Master of Arts in Education and Multiple Subject or Single Subject Teaching Credential.
- June 2010 – May/June 2011
- 60–80 candidates in the Single Subject Program.
25 in the Multiple Subject Program

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Clinical work - Placement

- Placements are with partner schools that are actively engaged in projects of school reform
- STEP-Secondary teacher candidates (TCs) are placed in year-long classroom teaching
- Summer placement : Middle school June-August
- 20 hours/week. 2 hours/daily with your subject C.T.
2 hours/daily visit expert teachers in other subjects.

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Clinical work - Placement

- 3 times/quarter supervisor observations
- Peer observation/audit
- School Shadowing
- Supervisory meeting: Wednesdays with food
